

Brief History

The University of Kerala has established ten center's for Teacher Education to offer the B.Ed Course under its direct control and supervision with the approval of the University of Kerala as part of its general policy to initiate steps to promote Teacher education as well as to accommodate the large number of highly qualified candidates who seek admission to B.Ed course of other states and within the states and who are often forced to enter Teacher Education Centres in other states in carrying high financial expenditure and where the quality of education is not assured. It is the proud privilege of the Syndicate of the University of Kerala to translate the scheme into reality and to present the prestigious center's to the discerning and enlightened public of Kerala as a well-conceived measure which is a significant step into endeavours to maintain and improve standards in higher education in general and professional education in particular. The KUCTE Anchal is one of the ten prestigious institutions established by the University in the eastern hilly region of Kollam District, Kerala State. The college which was originally started functioning in 1994 at Punalur was shifted to Anchal in 1998 in view of better facilities. Since then its has been functioning in its own campus at Government H.S.S, Anchal West.

General discipline of the Institution

Opening of Two year B.Ed Course

As per the NCTE norms classes started on the 27th of July 2017 this year. All the parents accompanied their wards to attend the one-day orientation conducted by the institution for familiarizing the new two year course to them. Very positive response was expressed by the participants.

Facilities /Admission

As per the direction of the NCTE the college offers admission to 50 in four optional subjects (English, Malayalam, Natural Science, Physical Science) every year. Admission to the College is made from the rank list prepared on the basis of merit and principles of communal reservation. The college has well stacked library with more than 7250 books, 150 CDs and more than 25 journals. The college also has a well-equipped Computer Lab, Language Lab, Science Lab (Physical Science and Natural Science) Psychology Lab and Physical Education Lab etc.

The college has been functioning in four permanent buildings which were contributed with financial aids of PTA, MPs, MLAs and Local Self Governments.

The process of admission for the academic year 2017-18 completed by 11 August 2017. The total strength on the role is 50. The subject wise distribution of strength is as follows:




The students from the physical science department actively participating in all the programs that are organized by the college (Independents day, Onam celebration, Gandhi Bhavan, Teacher's day etc).
