Brief History

The University of Kerala has established ten centres for Teacher Education to offer the B.Ed Course under its direct control and supervision with the approval of the University of Kerala as part of its general policy to initiate steps to promote Teacher education as well as to accommodate the large number of highly qualified candidates who seek admission to B.Ed course of other states and within the states and who are often forced to enter Teacher Education Centres in other states in carrying high financial expenditure and where the quality of education is not assured. It is the proud privilege of the Syndicate of the University of Kerala to translate the scheme into reality and to present the prestigious centres to the discerning and enlightened public of Kerala as a well conceived measure which is a significant step into endeavours to maintain and improve standards in higher education in general and professional education in particular. The KUCTE Anchal is one of the ten prestigious institutions established by the University in the eastern hilly region of Kollam District, Kerala State. The college which was originally started functioning in 1994 at Punalur was shifted to Anchal in 1998 in view of better facilities . Since then its has been functioning in its own campus at Government H.S.S, Anchal West.

Mission

Our mission is to secure the nation by supplying ideal teachers-well versed in the subject, dedicated to the cause of education and ever willing to guide the younger generation in the right path. We always focus on the promises kept and the miles to go to reach the destination.

Facilities /Admission

As per the direction of the NCTE the college offers admission to 165 students in six optional subjects (English, Malayalam, Mathematic, Natural Science, Physical Science and Social Science) every year. Admission to the College is made from the rank list prepared on the basis of merit and principles of communal reservation. The college has well stacked library with more than 6677 books, 150 CDs and more than 25 journals. The college also has a well equipped Computer Lab, Language Lab, Science Lab (Physical Science and Natural Science) Psychology Lab and Physical Education Lab etc.

The college has been functioning in four permanent buildings which were contributed with financial aids of PTA, MPs, MLAs and Local Self Governments.

The process of admission for the academic year 2013-14 was completed by November 2013. The total strength on the role is 165. The subject wise distribution of strength is as follows:
